Satoshi Matsuo's Career History

- 1964: Appointed Director, Calbee, Inc.
- 1967: Appointed Executive Vice President, Calbee, Inc.
- 1987: Appointed President and Representative Director, Calbee, Inc.
- 1992: Appointed Chairman of the Board, Calbee, Inc.
- 2001: Appointed Director and Special Adviser, Calbee, Inc.
- 2002: Appointed Special Adviser, Calbee, Inc.
- 2005: Appointed Honorary Adviser, Calbee, Inc.
- 2010: Resigned as Honorary Adviser, Calbee, Inc.

Achievements

Satoshi Matsuo, along with the Calbee founder, Takashi Matsuo, was instrumental in the launch of Kappa Ebisen, Calbee's long-selling product, and the company's entry into the potato chips business. Under Satoshi's leadership, Calbee expanded its production system and started overseas business operations. In 1988 when he served as President, he led the company in its start of the cereal business and built a solid foundation for its growth in the market. In addition, Satoshi made a remarkable contribution to the snack and cereal food industry as the Chairman of the National Wheat and Rice Cracker Association (currently known as the Japan Snack Cereal Foods Association).
