Calbee Expands Research Building at Utsunomiya R&D Center

Building is now twice as large, enhances core R&D capabilities, and modernizes how teams work



Tokyo – Calbee, Inc. ("Calbee") announced today that it has completed the expansion of the Research Building at its R&D Center in Utsunomiya City, Japan. The building now offers nearly double the total floor area and triple the space dedicated to research. Its expansion is designed to strengthen Calbee's expertise in basic, applied, and quality-focused research, as well as in flavor and texture development—key drivers of its long-term innovation and growth.

Background

Since its opening in 2004, Calbee's R&D Center has served as the company's hub for research and development, as well as pilot-scale production of new products.

Within the Research Building, Calbee carries out research such as on the benefits of natural ingredients, as well as product development efforts such as creating new product concepts and packaging solutions. To foster greater collaboration, Calbee has added new areas to and renovated the building. Construction began in February 2024 and was completed on April 1, 2025.

Features of the Research Building

The expanded Research Building dedicates nearly three times as much space to research, significantly increasing the number of laboratories. At the heart of the facility is an open workspace designed around Activity-Based Working (ABW)*1 and a free-address system. This environment allows employees to choose where they work based on their daily tasks and preferences—encouraging cross-departmental collaboration and supporting both productivity and job satisfaction.

To further enhance the working environment, the building incorporates the principles of Biophilic design. Locally sourced wood and Oya stone from Tochigi Prefecture are used throughout the workspace interiors. By integrating natural textures and materials, the space is designed to reduce stress and promote focus.

As part of its growth strategy, Calbee has set a target of achieving a 5% sales ratio from new business areas, focusing on expanding its agribusiness and the food and health sectors. Research efforts cover crops such as potatoes, sweet potatoes, and beans, as well as emerging fields like gut health and sleep.

Calbee will continue to strengthen its research foundation and develop its R&D talent—contributing to healthier lives and a more sustainable future.
